2010 MEMBERSHIP DUES

Mining Members: Firms or organizations who are actively engaged in the exploration of, or the development, extraction processing, or benefaction of mineral resources within the State of Utah. Basic annual membership dues plus a prorated assessment. The prorated assessment for 2010 is \$60.50 **per person in Utah engaged in mining, milling, concentrating and processing, including management and supervision, and the manpower equivalents or related contract work.**

Example: If you have 8 people engaged in mining in Utah, you would times \$60.50 by 8 which would equal \$484.00. You would then add your basic annual dues of \$300 to your prorated assessment of \$484.00 for a total of \$784.00.
